Relay For Life is a community gathering rather than an athletic event, anyone and everyone can participate. It offers everyone in the community a chance to participate in the fight against cancer. Teams of people camp out at Cardinal Stritch High School and take turns walking or running around a track or path. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event. Friends, relatives, local businesses, hospitals, schools, churches, and other organizations form teams with 8-15 people. Each participant is asked to raise a minimum of \$100 and all of those funds go directly back to this global fight against cancer.
